

# CAMP GROSSMAN TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Thank you for choosing Camp Grossman. We look forward to sharing camp with your child for the season. Please read the Camp Grossman Terms and Conditions, below:

## PAYMENT POLICY

**Deposit:** A one-time, non-refundable, deposit of \$250 is due upon registration. Registration is not complete and a spot will not be held for your child until the deposit is received. Deposit paid by credit card will not incur a service fee.

**Tuition:** You must pay half of the registration fee or have a payment plan in place by March 30. The remainder of the camp tuition is due or a payment plan must be in place by May 1. Failure to pay in full may result in loss of enrollment and forfeiture of the non-refundable deposit. Any registration submitted after May 1 requires full payment at that time. Payment is accepted in the following forms: Check, Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) and Credit Card\*.

**\*EFT/Credit Card:** You may opt to pay your camp tuition by credit card in full or on a monthly payment plan. Email [grossman@jccgb.org](mailto:grossman@jccgb.org) with any questions related to tuition or payment plans. Paying by credit card will incur a 3% service fee. There are no service fees for paying by EFT.

**Discounts:** Visit [bostonjcc.org/grossman](http://bostonjcc.org/grossman) or contact the camp office for more details. A change in JCC Greater Boston Membership will result in an automatic rate change.

**Financial Assistance:** Requests for financial assistance must be made by March 1. Requests made after March 1 will depend on available funds. Awards are not guaranteed year to year or for weeks added after March 1.

**Refunds:** There are no refunds for illness, partial weeks attended or changed plans. Tuition is non-refundable.

## WEEK CHANGE POLICY

**Before March 1:** Weeks may be dropped, or added or changed **Subject to Availability**, as long as the 2 week minimum (not including the 9th week) is maintained. To request changes, please email [grossman@jccgb.org](mailto:grossman@jccgb.org).

**After March 1:** There is a \$50 per week per child fee for any weeks dropped, a 2 week minimum must be maintained. Changes to weeks attending may be made, **Subject to Availability**, as long as number of weeks remains the same or increases. There is a \$50 transaction fee each time a change is made. If we cannot accommodate your week change and you must drop weeks, each week dropped is subject to the \$50 drop fee.

**On and After May 1:** Full payment is due or a payment plan must be in place and no refunds will be issued. You can not drop weeks after this date. Weeks may be changed **Subject to Availability** and a \$50 transaction fee per child is charged every time a change is made. If we cannot accommodate your weeks change, you are financially responsible for the number of weeks for which your camper is registered.

## COVID POLICY

In the event that Camp Grossman must close your child's bunk, or all of camp, due to state or local mandate, Camp Grossman will do our best to fit you into another week, session or JCC camp program as you prefer. If we are unable to accommodate you, JCC Greater Boston will credit your account for use in a future program.

## ILLNESS

Keep children home if they are not feeling well. Campers with a fever will not be admitted to camp. Campers who develop a fever or other symptoms of illness will be sent home. Campers will be asked to follow precautions and regulations regarding COVID-19, which will be updated based on current conditions and provided before camp begins. Parents are expected to arrange prompt pickup of any child who is ill.

## EXPECTED BEHAVIOR

We encourage everyone to follow appropriate COVID guidance from the CDC and local Boards of Health, at all times, both within and outside of camp. Camp is an exciting, fun, sociable and nurturing experience. Campers are expected to be respectful of each other, counselors, and the facilities. Any campers endangering themselves or others may be asked to leave camp. Parents may request a copy of the discipline policy at any time. Refunds are not given to campers who are asked to withdraw.

## CAMPER READINESS

All campers should be able to enjoy a day full of activity without a nap. All campers must be able to use the restrooms independently (including the awareness and ability to vocalize the need to use the restroom, ability to get to the restroom with enough lead time, managing clothing, wiping, flushing and washing hands) in order to attend camp.
