

How to Play Dreidel



Playing dreidel is a fun way to celebrate the holiday and create family memories.

Here's how:

- All players get an equal number of pennies, chocolate coins (gelt), candies, raisins or tokens.
- All players put one token in the pot (in the center).
- The dreidel is a four-sided spinning top with a different Hebrew letter on each side. Players take turns spinning the dreidel.



Nun: player gets nothing



Gimel: player takes all of the tokens from the pot



Hay: player takes half of the tokens from the pot



Shin: player puts one token into the pot

- The player acts according to the letter that is facing up when the dreidel stops spinning.
- The winner is the one with the most tokens when everyone is tired of taking turns.
