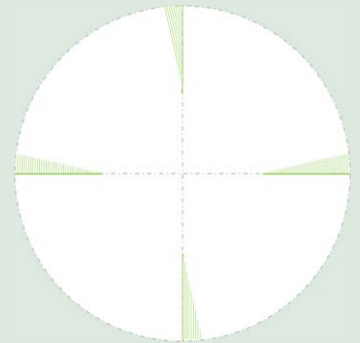




Paper Kippah (Yarmulke) Craft

Materials:

- paper (photocopy weight paper is fine)
- small plate or compass to trace around
- scissors
- sticky tape
- decorating materials (markers, stickers, etc.)



Directions:

- Draw a circle on a piece of paper (7" paper plate recommended. If your child wants to wear the finished product, you may need to make it smaller)
- Decorate the inside of your circle
- Cut out the circle, carefully fold it in half, then into quarters. Unfold it again. You will need to cut halfway along each of the four lines you have just made in the paper. (See where the green lines are on the image above)
- Once you have made your cuts, gently overlap the two edges of each cut (as per the green shaded area above, adjusting it to the shape you want) and secure it with sticky tape
- Just add a hairclip and wear your new kippah with pride
