# Stained Glass Window Suncatcher

## Materials:

- Card or paper (A3 card recommended)
- Colored cellophane
- Sticky tape
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Scissors or stanley knife
- Cutting mat (optional)

## Directions:

- Make a template for your design
- Use the template to copy the pattern onto the piece of card or paper you want for your finished product
- Cut out the shapes to make a frame
- Cut cellophane into pieces 2-3 inches wide and roughly rectangular, but this could vary depending on the size of the “holes” in your design
- Stick pieces of cellophane onto the frame using sticky tape. For brighter colors, use two thicknesses of the same color, or overlap differing colors
- Turn over and hold up to the light. For a neater finish (if you are displaying it on a window where you’ll regularly see both sides), put a duplicate frame on the back
